Ancient Egypt

In year 7, the first Unit you will study is ancient civilisations. To prepare for this, I would like you to research the ancient Egyptians and, the discovery of the Tomb of Tutankhamun.

You can choose to do as many as you like but the higher the points, the harder the task.

For 5 points =

- Research ancient Egyptian artefacts and what they were used for. Then create a poster advertising an Egyptian museum collection. (This can be done on the computer)
- Write a short newspaper report announcing the discovery of Tutankhamen's tomb. (Include a Catchy Headline!)
- Find an interesting paragraph about Ancient Egypt in a book. Make notes and write about it in your own words. Do not forget to write title of book.

For 8 points =

- Write your own Egyptian poem.
- Imagine that you are Howard Carter, write a description of entering the tomb for the first time. (It was dark with the chink of light from the opening we had made. The air was stuffy and closed all around us...)

For 10 points =

- Write a biography report on Howard Carter - who was he? Why is he famous?
